DIVISION OF PURSE:

1. **\$300.00 added to each class if there are 3 entries, (in the case of 2 entries \$200.00 will be added, in the case of 1 entry \$100.00 will be added),** plus 80% of the entry fees. Additional monies may be added if available. 20% of all fees go to the D.Q.H.A. for office fees. **ALL MONIES WILL BE PAID BACK**
2. Maximum of six ribbons/monies paid in each class: 40% - 25% - 15% - 10% - 5% - 5%
3. **Checks will be mailed within 30 days after "Sun Circuit" conclusion to eligible winners.**

RULES:

1. Open to all D.Q.H.A. members in good standing. **Entries must be sired by a Delaware Stallion or foaled by a Delaware Owned Mare.** All Owners and Exhibitors must be paid members of the D.Q.H.A. If a breeder has met all requirements to show the futurity, and then sells the horse prior to the show, that horse is still eligible for the futurity, if the new owner is a member or becomes a member of D.Q.H.A. prior to showing the horse.
2. Yearlings must be registered A.Q.H.A. to be eligible, must have entered as a weanling and paid all fees required for weanlings and breeder/owner(s) must have been a member in of the D.Q.H.A. in good standing. Snaffle Bit entries must be registered A.Q.H.A. and have entered as a weanling, and paid all fees required for weanling, yearling, 2 Y.O. and 3 Y.O. and breeder/owner(s) must have been a member(s) in good standing.
3. Yearlings and Snaffle Bit payments as a 2 year-old and as a 3 year-old must be made in one lump sum.
4. Transfer of Ownership will not hurt eligibility as long as the new owner(s) meets all requirements.
5. No letter of hardships will be accepted.
6. Farm or Corporation must have one appointed representative to meet the requirement
7. **Photocopy of registration papers must be included of yearlings and snaffle bit horses to futurity chairperson when nominated. Also, the exhibitor's A.Q.H.A. number is required.**
8. Health and immunization records as required by "Summer Sun Circuit" rules must be presented at time of check in.
